

PRIVACY

The Internet is a powerful tool that allows people to exchange information freely. Because the Minot Family YMCA collects information via ymcaminot.org, we have policies regarding how we use the information we collect.

Categories of Information

Information about you can be categorized as (a) personally identifiable information or (b) non-personally identifiable information. "Personally identifiable information" is information that we collect from you such as your name, postal address, telephone number, fax number and e-mail address. "Non-personally identifiable information" is information that we collect from you that cannot be used to identify or contact you, such as your Web site browsing patterns or demographic information.

How We Use and Disclose Information

The Minot Family YMCA will use your personally identifiable information to provide you with information that you may request, including organization updates, and to customize your experience on the Web site. We may also combine the information we have gathered about you with information from other sources, such as other Web sites operated by our organization, to better serve your needs. Unless notified, we may use your personally identifiable information to contact you about offers or promotions we think you would be interested in. If you do not want to receive this information, indicate that we may not do so at the point where you give us your personally identifiable information. If you wish to receive such information in the future, simply e-mail us at minotymca@srt.com. Please note that changes to your preferences may not be effective immediately.

Please note that the Minot Family YMCA utilizes third-party contractors to help us operate our business operations, such as operating the server for the Web site and sending postal mail and e-mail, and may share your information with these contractors for those limited purposes. The Minot Family YMCA requires that contractors do not disclose personally identifiable information or use it other than as necessary to perform services for our organization.

Because we care about your privacy, we will not give your personally identifiable information to third parties such as marketers or retailers for use in contacting you about offers or promotions of their own (other than in connection with the sale of our organization) unless you allow us to. If you would like us to share your personally identifiable information with third parties so that you may receive these special offers and promotions, indicate that we may do so at the point where you give us such personally identifiable information. Please note that changes to your preferences may not be effective immediately.

In the event that all of our business assets are transferred to or acquired by another company, customer information will be one of the transferred assets. We will also divulge your personal information to law enforcement officials if required to do so by law.

How We Collect Information

The Minot Family YMCA will collect personally identifiable information from you when you actively provide us the information. Examples of this may include email registration, completed online surveys and online membership registration applications, requests for information or newsletters and participation in community features. All information that the Minot Family YMCA collects from their consumers will reside on servers owned and operated by DAXKO, a third-party service provider.

Like many other Web sites, the Minot Family YMCA may collect non-personal, identifiable information from you by "passive" means (i.e., tracking consumer use of the Web site, often through the use of cookies). That information includes, among other things, the type of computer operating system and Web browser that are being used and the domain name of your Internet service provider, as well as some of the information described below. We use this information for internal purposes and to help us interact with visitors to the Web site. We may also share this information in the aggregate form with third parties to illustrate trends and patterns.

Cookies

A cookie is a small data file that is placed on your computer's hard drive that may contain information (such as a unique user ID) that a Web site may use to track certain characteristics. The Minot Family YMCA may use cookies in order to improve your site experience. The cookie helps to track the pages of the Web site that you visit, informs us of your prior screening history of the Web site, and provides us with information on which Web site you visit immediately before your visit to our Web site. It does not tell us about your use of any other Web sites. If you do not wish to make this information available to us, you can disable the cookies by turning them off from your browser. Please note however, that if you turn off your cookies, then display of the registration form will reoccur.

Special Policies for Children

The ymcaminot.org site is a general-audience site that provides content that may be of interest to children 13 years of age and younger. Due to the fact that ymcaminot.org has certain policies regarding the use of personally identifiable information about children under the age of 13, users who fall in this age range may not have access to all of the services and products offered by ymcaminot.org.

Registration

If a user under the age of 13 attempts to register or join any Web site or property controlled or owned by ymcaminot.org, the registration will not be completed or accepted until the consent of the child's parent is secured. If a user under the age of 13 attempts to register for an account with ymcaminot.org or another Web site, the user must provide information sufficient to allow ymcaminot.org to secure the permission of the child's parent to utilize our products and services. This information will include the parent's e-mail address, mailing address, phone number and full name.

The ymcaminot.org site may require that children under the age of 13 provide the same information required of all other users to establish a user account, including first and last name, e-mail address, birth date, ZIP code and personal interests. The ymcaminot.org site uses this information to personalize the user experience, maintain account integrity and accounting and provide customized marketing and advertising information to our users.

At no time will ymcaminot.org require that a child under 13 years of age, as a condition of participation in an activity or to utilize our products or services, provide more information than is reasonably necessary. This is a requirement of the Children's Online Privacy Protection Act (COPPA) and ymcaminot.org strictly abides by this requirement.

Disclosure of Information to Others

The ymcaminot.org site will not sell or rent personally identifiable information about children under 13 years of age to anyone.

The ymcaminot.org site will not contact children under the age of 13 about products, services or for marketing purposes without the express written consent of the child's parent.

The ymcaminot.org site may share personally identifiable information of a child under 13 years of age with other parties, companies and people when required by law or required to do so to comply with a subpoena, court order or legal process; or when explicit permission has been granted by a child's parent or legal guardian.

Security

Protecting your order information is important to us. Our third-party service provider, DAXKO, uses the industry standard security measures to protect the security of your information. Unfortunately, no data transmission over the Internet can be guaranteed to be 100 percent secure.
